A Metrobus mechanic must:

- Perform tasks in any of several areas of the bus maintenance activity.
- Perform major repairs on all designated component parts of vehicles and analyzes and corrects those components having special or new problems.
- Conduct technical diagnostics performs major engine work, etc.
- Perform all tasks in conformance with safety and maintenance practices and procedures.
- Use various types of test equipment and related specialized tools associated with job assignment.
- Complete required documentation and reports for the operation and maintenance of WMATA vehicles and related components by using the proper forms and tags.
- Attend on-the-job and formal training classes: Assist higher classified co-workers in their assignments or provide job specific training to lower classified co-workers.
- Perform flame cutting and basic welding operations, brazing and soldering as required.
- Respond to and provide assistance in emergencies such as securing or safeguarding WMATA vehicles and equipment, fire/life/safety, snow emergencies, etc.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency certificate.
- Some knowledge of and have performed satisfactorily the duties of a Shop Mechanic or related field for a period of not less than two (2) years.
- Must have one (1) current ASE certification in one field (Transit Bus, Automotive, Medium/Heavy Truck or School Bus) or completed formal military training in wheel mechanics and acquired the military occupational skill (MOS).
- Valid Commercial Drivers Learner's Permit from jurisdiction of residence is required prior to appointment with proper Passenger, Air Brakes, and Tow Truck operations endorsements. Must acquire a valid Commercial Driver's License with Passenger, Air Brakes and Tow Truck operations endorsements by the completion of training.
- Ability to work various hours, locations or days.
- Ability to deal courteously and effectively with others.
- Possess the necessary tools to accomplish the required tasks of the specific job position and the ability to acquire the complete minimum tool requirement within ninety (90) calendar days of promotion/appointment.
